## Sheriff's Report

## February 09, 2018

Randolph County Sheriff Mark Nichols reports the following incidents, reports, investigations and arrests.

On February 02<sup>nd</sup> at 4:15 am, a deputy was dispatched to a business in Huntsville in reference to an individual asleep in a vehicle in the parking lot of the business. Contact was made with the individual to see if he was impaired. The subject advised that he was tired and pulled in to rest. No further action taken.

On February 02<sup>nd</sup> at 6:00 am, a deputy was dispatched to a location on Highway 63, north of Clark in reference to a vehicle fire. Upon arrival, the deputy noted that Eastern Fire District was on scene and extinguished the fire. The deputy conducted traffic control while the Missouri State Highway Patrol investigated the incident. The deputy remained on scene until the highway was cleared.

On February 02<sup>nd</sup> at 7:38 pm, a Moberly resident was served an order for 96-hour detention, evaluation and treatment. The subject was transported to University of Missouri Psychiatric Center in Columbia without incident.

On February 03<sup>rd</sup> at 9:31 am a deputy was dispatched to a location in the 1300 block of County Road 1610 in reference to a theft. The complainant reported that on January 30<sup>th</sup>, someone stole a transport bar from a Preifert cattle chute. The investigation continues.

The deputy learned that the individual was attempting to repair taillights on his trailer before traveling further. No further action taken.

Warrant one for failure to appear on an infraction of driver/front seat passenger fail to wear properly adjusted/fastened safety belt. Bond set at \$100 cash only. Warrant two for failure to appear on a class A misdemeanor charge of driving while revoked/suspended – 2<sup>nd</sup> or subsequent offense. Bond set at \$2,000 cash only. Gullett was released on her own recognizance by the court.

On February 05<sup>th</sup>, 33-year old Taleana Marie Ames a/k/a Taleana M. Cliver of Moberly was served two Randolph County warrants. Warrant one for failure to appear on an infraction of driver/front seat passenger fail to wear properly adjusted/fastened safety belt. Bond set at \$10 cash only. Warrant two for failure to appear on a class D misdemeanor charge of operate motor vehicle owned by another knowing owner of vehicle has no maintained financial responsibility. Bond set at \$97.50. Ames posted the required bond and released.

On February 05<sup>th</sup>, 37-year old Jesse (Jessie) Lee Houston of Clifton Hill was served a Randolph County warrant on a class E felony charge of leaving the scene of an accident – property damage exceeding \$1000. Bond set at \$5,000 cash or surety. Houston posted the required bond and released.

On February 05<sup>th</sup>, 57-year old Christine R. Schenewerk of Centralia was served a Randolph County warrant for failure to appear on an infraction of failed to display plates on motor vehicle/trailer. Bond set at \$200 cash only. Schenewerk posted the required bond and released.

On February 05<sup>th</sup>, 57-year old Timothy Howard Plaskie of Moberly was served a Randolph county warrant on a class A misdemeanor charge of violation of order of protection for adult – 1<sup>st</sup> offense. Bond set at \$2,500 cash or surety. Plaskie posted the required bond and released.

On February 05<sup>th</sup>, 32-year old Ricco Valentino Marshall of Moberly was served a Randolph County warrant on a class D felony charge of domestic assault – 2<sup>nd</sup> degree. Bond set at \$20,000. Marshall remains in the Randolph County Jail in lieu of the required bond.

On February 05<sup>th</sup>, 41-year old John D. Vandyke of Saline County, Illinois was served three warrants. Warrant one from Saline County, Illinois for a felony probation violation. Bond set at \$10,000 surety or 10% cash. Warrant two from Saline County, Illinois for a felony charge of failure to appear on a violation on probation for driving while license revoked. Bond set at \$10,000 cash or surety. Warrant three from Randolph County on an unclassified felony charge of fugitive from out of state. Bond set at \$25,000 cash only. Vandyke remains in custody, awaiting extradition to Illinois.

On February 6<sup>th</sup>, 50-year old Thomas Charles Lee of rural Moberly was served a Randolph County warrant for delivery of a controlled substance except 35 grams or less of Marijuana or Synthetic Cannabinoid and possession of a controlled substance except 35 grams or less of Marijuana or Synthetic Cannabinoid. Bond set at \$25,000 cash only. Lee remains in the Randolph County Jail in lieu of the required bond.

On February 6<sup>th</sup>, 40-year old Rodney Kintia Oliver of Columbia was served a Randolph County warrant for a probation violation on a class D felony charge of operated vehicle on highway without a valid license – 3<sup>rd</sup> and subsequent offense and a class B misdemeanor charge of driving while intoxicated – drug intoxication. No bond set. Oliver remains in the Randolph County Jail in lieu of the required bond.

On February 7<sup>th</sup>, 48-year old Jason Wayne Cleeton of Moberly was served a Randolph County warrant on a class D felony charge of driving while intoxicated – aggravated offender. Bond set at \$10,000 cash or surety. Cleeton posted the required bond and released.

On February 7<sup>th</sup>, 18-year old Kalie M. Mattingly of Moberly was served a Randolph County warrant for failure to appear on three class A misdemeanor charges of stealing. Bond set at \$500 cash only. Mattingly posted the required bond and released.

On February 7<sup>th</sup>, 27-year old Larry Gene Hornbarger Jr. of Madison was served a Randolph County warrant on a class C felony charge of possession of a controlled substance except 35 grams or less of Marijuana. Bond set at \$45,000 cash or surety. Hornbarger remains in the Randolph County Jail in lieu of the required bond.

On February 7<sup>th</sup>, 36-year old Joshua W. Steffen of Salem was served a Randolph County warrant for failure to appear on a class A misdemeanor charge of driving while intoxicated – prior offender, a class D misdemeanor charge of driving while revoked/suspended – 1<sup>st</sup> offense and an infraction of driver/front seat passenger failed to wear properly adjusted/fastened safety belt. Bond set at \$1,000 cash only. Steffen remains in the Randolph County Jail in lieu of the required bond.
