Sheriff's Report

March 23, 2018

Randolph County Sheriff Mark Nichols reports the following incidents, reports, investigations and arrests.

On March 16th at 8:33 am, a deputy was dispatched to a location on County Road 1245 in reference to a pickup setting in the road. The deputy arrived and ran the registration, learning the name and address of the owner. The deputy responded to the address given and met with a family member who advised that the owner was on the way to retrieve the vehicle.

On March 16th, deputies responded to a residence in rural Huntsville to serve an order of 96hour detention, evaluation and treatment. The subject was transported to Missouri University Psychiatric Center without incident.

On March 16th at 5:05 pm, a deputy was dispatched to a residence in the 500 Block of East Elm Street in Huntsville in reference to a report of illegal trash dumping. The deputy is attempting to locate possible suspects. The investigation continues.

On March 16th at 5:58 pm, a deputy and a Missouri State Trooper, responded to a residence in the 100 block of North Powell Street in Jacksonville because of an assault. The victim reported that his son had assaulted him by striking him in the head and face numerous times and threatening him with a knife. The victim had severe injuries consistent with his claim. The officers searched for the suspect, finding him hiding in a garage. The suspect was taken into custody and transported to the Randolph County Jail. The report has been forwarded to the Randolph County Prosecuting Attorney for review and formal action.

On March 17th, at 5:30 pm, a deputy was requested to contact a rural Moberly resident concerning a neighbor's dogs running loose with his cattle. The deputy contacted the owner of the dogs and advised him to keep his dogs contained to prevent them from injuring the neighbor's livestock or the dogs becoming injured. No further action taken.

On March 18th at 7:34 pm, a deputy was dispatched to a residence in the 1300 block of County Road 1215 in reference to a domestic disturbance. The deputy met with both parties who advised that they had been involved in a verbal argument. Neither party would agree to leave the residence. At 11:37 pm, deputies were called to the residence again. Both parties advised that they had gotten into another argument. The male subject was persuaded to find another location to stay for the night.

On March 20th, at 4:38 pm was dispatched to a residence in the 200 block of Eastwood Street in Higbee for a report of a theft. The complainant reported that someone stole his Sthil Wood boss chainsaw. The complainant provided the name of a possible suspect. The investigation continues.

On March 16th, Jeanette Elizabeth Fisk, 39 of rural Clark was served an Audrain County warrant on a class D felony charge of sexual misconduct or attempt, involving a child less than 15 years of age – 1st offense, a class D felony charge of sexual contact with student by teacher, student teacher, employee, contract employee school official or volunteer, an unclassified felony charge of attempted enticement of a child and a class A misdemeanor charge of furnishing pornographic material or attempt to furnish to a minor. Bond set at \$20,000 cash only. Fisk was turned over to Audrain County authorities.

On March 16th, Christina Kay Simpson (Saunders), 20 of rural Moberly was served a Randolph County warrant on a class B felony charge of assault 1st degree or attempt and an unclassified felony charge of armed criminal action. Bond set at \$10,000 cash or surety. Simpson posted the required bond and released.

On March 16th, Isaac Bryant, 31 of Columbia was served a Randolph County warrant for a probation violation on a class C felony charge of accessory to assault – 2^{nd} degree and a class B felony charge of accessory to robbery – 2^{nd} degree. Bond set at \$20,000 cash or surety. Bryant remains incarcerated.

On March 16th, Cawon Dontele Midgyett, 30 of Moberly was served five Randolph County warrants. Warrant one for failure to obey a judge's order on a class A misdemeanor charge of assault 3rd degree and a class A misdemeanor charge of domestic assault 3rd degree. Bond set at \$1,000 cash only. Warrant two for failure to obey a judge's order on a class A misdemeanor charge of receiving stolen property. Bond set at \$500 cash only. Warrant three for failure to obey a judge's order on a class A misdemeanor charge of endanger correctional employee/visitor/another by attempting/know causing person to come in contact with unidentified substance. Bond set at \$500 cash only. Warrant four for failure to obey a judge's order on a class A misdemeanor charge of resisting/interfering with arrest, detention or stop and a class A misdemeanor charge of possession of up to 35 grams of Marijuana. Bond set at \$500 cash only. Warrant five for failure to obey a judge's order on a class A misdemeanor charge of possession of up to 35 grams of Marijuana. Bond set at \$500 cash only. Warrant five for failure to obey a judge's order on a class A misdemeanor charge of possession of up to 35 grams of Marijuana. Bond set at \$500 cash only. Warrant five for failure to obey a judge's order on a class A misdemeanor charge of resisting/interfering with arrest, detention or stop and a class A misdemeanor charge of possession of up to 35 grams of Marijuana. Bond set at \$500 cash only. Warrant five for failure to obey a judge's order on a class A misdemeanor charge of resisting/interfering with arrest, detention or stop. Bond set at \$1,000 cash only. Midgyett remains incarcerated.

On March 16th, Joshua Adam Hill, 39 of Moberly was served two Randolph County warrants. Warrant one for failure to appear on an ordinance violation of stealing. Bond set at \$300 cash only. Warrant two on a class B felony charge of burglary – 1st degree, a class A felony charge of domestic assault 1st degree – serious physical injury, a class E felony charge of unlawful use of a weapon, a class B felony charge of domestic assault – 1st degree – 1st offense and an unclassified felony charge of armed criminal action. Bond set at \$25,000 cash only. Hill remains in the Randolph County Jail in lieu of the required bond.

On March 19th, Deseray Lynn Woods, 32 of Moberly was served a Randolph County warrant for failure to appear on an ordinance violation of shoplifting. Bond set at \$300 cash only. Woods posted the required bond and released.

On March 19th, Jamie Lynn Clark, 27 of rural Moberly was served a Randolph County warrant for failure to appear on an ordinance violation of defective equipment. Bond set at \$125 cash only. Clark posted the required bond and released.

On March 19th, Brandy Marie Dietzman, 36 of Bunceton was served a Randolph County warrant for failure to appear on an unclassified misdemeanor charge of driving while revoked/suspended – 2nd or subsequent offense. Bond set at \$200 cash only. Dietzman posted the required bond and released.

On March 19th, Barbara Sue Ross (Shields) (Hosmer), 60 of Moberly was served a Randolph County warrant on a class D felony charge of possession of a controlled substance except 35 grams or less of Marijuana/Synthetic Cannabinoid and a class E felony charge of keeping or maintaining a public nuisance. Bond set at \$10,000 cash or surety. Ross posted the required bond and released.

On March 19th, Kent Christopher Flood, 33 of Moberly was served a Randolph County warrant on two class D felony charges of possession of a controlled substance except 35 grams or less of Marijuana/Synthetic Cannabinoid. Bond set at \$10,000 cash or surety. Flood posted the required bond and released.

On March 19th, Corey Wayne Daggett, 46 of Moberly was served a Randolph County warrant on a class A misdemeanor charge of stealing leased or rented property. Bond set at \$120.50 cash only. Daggett posted the required bond and released.

On March 19th, Jodi Mae Douglas, 35 of Moberly was served a Randolph County warrant for failure to appear on a class D misdemeanor charge of operated vehicle on highway without a valid license – 1^{st} offense and a class D misdemeanor charge of owner operated motor vehicle without maintaining financial responsibility – 1^{st} offense. Bond set at \$150 cash only. Warrant two for failure to appear on an infraction of driver/front seat passenger failed to wear properly adjusted/fastened safety belt. Bond set at \$10 cash only. Parizo posted the required bond and released.

On March 20th, Richard Lee Jordan, 51 of Columbia was served a Randolph County warrant for failure to appear on a class C felony charge of unlawful possession of a firearm. Bond set at \$100,000 cash or surety. Jordan remains in the Randolph County Jail in lieu of the required bond.

On March 20th, Shawn Wade Briscoe, 42 of Moberly was served a Randolph County warrant on a felony class charge of unlawful use of a weapon. Bond set at \$5,000 cash or surety. Briscoe posted the required bond and released.

On March 20th, Richelle Renee Grapes, 44 of Moberly was served a Randolph County warrant on a class B felony charge of burglary 1st degree, a class D felony charge of assault – 2nd degree, a class D felony charge of stealing – controlled substance/meth manufacturing material, a class D felony charge of burglary – 2nd degree, a class D felony charge of possession of a controlled substance except 35 grams or less of Marijuana/Synthetic Cannabinoid and a class B felony charge of delivery of a controlled substance except 35 grams or less of Marijuana or Synthetic Cannabinoid. Bond set at \$40,000 cash or surety. Grapes posted the required bond and released.

On March 20th, Megan Elizabeth Swartz, 18 of Moberly was served two Randolph County warrants. Warrant one on a class D felony charge of stealing - \$750 or more and a class E felony charge of property damage 1st degree. Bond set at \$2,000 cash or surety. Warrant two for failure to appear on an ordinance violation of driver of motor vehicle failed to wear properly adjusted/fastened safety belt. Bond set at \$75 cash only. Swartz posted the required bond and released.

On March 21st, David Lee Green, 40 of rural Moberly was served three Randolph County warrants. Warrant one for failure to appear on a class A misdemeanor charge of theft/stealing of property or services of less than \$500. Bond set at \$250 cash only. Warrant two for failure to appear on an infraction of driver/front seat passenger fail to wear properly adjusted/fastened safety belt. Bond set at \$100 cash only. Warrant three on a class D felony charge of possession of a controlled substance except 35 grams or less of Marijuana/Synthetic Cannabinoid. Bond set at \$5,000 cash or surety. Green remains in the Randolph County Jail in lieu of the required bond.

On March 21st, Anthony Con Meyer, 20 of rural Higbee was served two Randolph County warrants. Warrant one for failure to appear on an unclassified misdemeanor charge of owner operated motor vehicle without maintaining financial responsibility – 2nd and subsequent offense, an infraction of driver/front seat passenger failed to wear properly adjusted/fastened safety belt and an infraction of driver failed to secure child under 8 years of age in child restraint or booster seat. Bond set at \$200 cash only. Warrant two for failure to appear on an unclassified misdemeanor charge of owner operated motor vehicle without maintaining financial responsibility – 2nd and subsequent offense, an infraction of driver failed to secure child under 8 years of age in child restraint or booster seat. Bond set at \$200 cash only. Warrant two for failure to appear on an unclassified misdemeanor charge of owner operated motor vehicle without maintaining financial responsibility – 2nd and subsequent offense, an infraction of driver/front seat passenger failed to wear properly adjusted/fastened safety belt and an infraction of driver failed to secure child under 8 years of age in child restraint or booster seat. Bond set at \$200 cash only. Meyer remains in the Randolph County Jail in lieu of the required bond.

On March 21st, Jeremy Allan (Allen) Bell, 23 of Madison was served a Randolph County warrant on three class D felony charges of possession of a controlled substance except 35 grams or less of Marijuana/Synthetic Cannabinoid and a class E felony charge of unlawful use of a weapon – possess weapon and a felony-controlled substance. Bond set at \$10,000 cash or surety. Bell remains in the Randolph County Jail in lieu of the required bond.

On March 21st, Benjamin Eugene Gorham, 22 of rural Moberly was served a Randolph County warrant for a probation violation on a class C felony charge of possession of a controlled substance except 35 grams or less of Marijuana, a class C felony charge of forgery and a class C

felony charge of possession of a forging instrument. Bond set at \$25,000 cash or surety. Gorham remains in the Randolph County Jail in lieu of the required bond.

On March 21st, Estil Eddie McDermit, 60 of Moberly was served a Randolph County warrant for a probation violation on a class E felony charge of driving while intoxicated – persistent offender. Bond set at \$7,500 cash or surety. McDermit remains in the Randolph County Jail in lieu of the required bond.

On March 22^{nd} , Justin B. Crites, 22 of rural Clark was served a Randolph County warrant for failure to appear on a class D felony charge of burglary – 2^{nd} degree. Bond set at \$1,500 cash only. Crites remains in the Randolph County Jail in lieu of the required bond.

On March 22nd, Carl Lee Bode, 36 of Moberly was served a Randolph County warrant for a probation violation on a class C felony charge of receiving stolen property, a class C felony charge of possession of a controlled substance except 35 grams or less of Marijuana and a class C felony charge of unlawful possession of a firearm. Bond set at \$10,000 cash only. Bode remains in the Randolph County Jail in lieu of the required bond.
