

Sheriff's Report

April 20, 2018

Randolph County Sheriff Mark Nichols reports the following incidents, reports, investigations and arrests.

On April 13th, a deputy was dispatched to a residence in the 4000 block of County Road 1245 in reference to a theft. The complainant reported that a used telephone pole had been removed from his property. The name of a possible suspect was obtained. The deputy attempted to locate the possible suspect to no avail. The suspect will be interviewed at a later time. The investigation continues.

On April 14th, a deputy was dispatched to a location on County Road 1650 in reference to assisting the Missouri State Highway Patrol with traffic control at the scene of a motor vehicle accident. The deputy remained on scene until the investigation was complete and scene cleared.

On April 14th, a deputy was dispatched to County Road 1870 in reference to an injured deer lying in the ditch. The deputy patrolled County Road 1870 without locating an injured deer.

On April 17th at 10:30 am, a deputy was dispatched to a residence in the 3900 block of County Road 2355 in reference to an unwanted individual person at the residence. Upon arrival, the complainant reported that her adult son would not abide by the residential rules and was causing a disturbance. The subject was asked to gather some personal belongings and leave the residence. The subject complied with the request.

On April 17th, at 9:15 pm, a deputy was dispatched to a residence in the 200 block of Evans Street in Higbee in reference to a structure fire. The deputy provided traffic control until the fire was extinguished.

On April 17th, a deputy was dispatched to a residence in the 400 block of South Main Street in Huntsville in reference to keeping the peace while one party retrieved personal property at the residence. The property was retrieved without incident.

On April 19th, a deputy was dispatched to a location on County Road 2635 in reference to cattle out of confinement. The deputy patrolled the area without locating any cattle.

On April 19th, while traveling on County Road 2540, a deputy met a vehicle that had an expired registration. The deputy initiated a traffic stop and identified the driver and passenger. The driver was issued a citation for failure to register a motor vehicle.

On April 16th, Christina Marie Lawson, 35 of Brunswick was served a Clay County warrant for a probation violation for the use of drug paraphernalia. Bond set at \$5,000 cash or surety. Lawson was unable to post the required bond and was extradited to Clay County.

On April 16th, Tanner Ray Spurlock was served a Randolph County warrant for failure to appear on a class B misdemeanor charge of operated a motor vehicle in a careless and imprudent manner and a class A misdemeanor charge of failed to yield to emergency vehicle sounding siren and displaying red/blue light. Bond set at \$500 cash only. Spurlock posted the required bond and released.

On April 16th, Nicole Banyon Johnson, 37 of rural Moberly was served a Randolph County warrant on a class D felony charge of possession of a controlled substance except 35 grams or less of Marijuana/Synthetic Cannabinoid. Bond set at \$2,000 cash or surety. Johnson posted the required bond and released.

On April 16th, Nathan Aaron Gallagher, 18 of Moberly was served a Randolph County warrant on a class E felony charge of delivery of 35 grams or less of Marijuana or Synthetic Cannabinoid. Bond set at \$5,000 cash or surety. Gallagher posted the required bond and released.

On April 16th, Alec Neil Bates, 19 of Moberly was served a Randolph County warrant on a class E felony charge of delivery of 35 grams or less of Marijuana or Synthetic Cannabinoid. Bond set at \$5,000 cash or surety. Bates posted the required bond and released.

On April 17th, Dakota Wayne Polson, 19 of Moberly was served a Randolph County warrant on two class B misdemeanor charges of peace disturbance – 1st offense. Bond set at \$2,500 cash only. Dakota Wayne Polson remains in the Randolph County Jail in lieu of the required bond.

On April 17th, Carson Lee (Dale) Polson, 21 of Moberly was served two Randolph County warrants. Warrant one on a class B misdemeanor charge of peace disturbance – 1st offense. Bond set at \$2,500 cash only. Warrant two for failure to obey a judge's order on a class D felony charge of possession of a controlled substance except 35 grams or less of Marijuana/Synthetic Cannabinoid. Bond set at \$2,500 cash only. Carson Lee (Dale) Polson remains in the Randolph County Jail in lieu of the required bond.

On April 17th, Chad Ryan Huffman, 39 of Higbee was served two Randolph County warrants. Warrant one on a class A misdemeanor charge of resisting or interfering with

arrest/detention/stop. Bond set at \$2,500 cash or surety. Warrant two for a probation violation on a class A misdemeanor charge of domestic assault – 3rd degree – 1st/2nd offense. Bond set at \$5,000 cash only. Huffman remains in the Randolph County Jail in lieu of the required bond.

Heather E. Muller a/k/a Heather Elaine Harper, 35 of Moberly was served a Randolph County warrant for a probation violation on three class C felony charges of forgery. Bond set at \$25,000 cash only with weekly drug testing. Muller posted the required bond and released.

On April 17th, Raymond Lee Wilborn, 49 of Moberly was served a Randolph County warrant on a class D felony charge of domestic assault – 2nd degree. Bond set at \$2,000 cash or surety. Wilborn posted the required bond and released.

On April 17th, Jasmine Raeshan Williams, 25 of St. Louis was served a Randolph County warrant on a class D felony charge of deliver or possession of a controlled substance at a county/private jail except with written prescription. Bond set at \$20,000 cash or surety. Williams posted the required bond and released.

On April 18th, Zachary Paul Martin, 28 of Callao was served a Randolph County warrant on a class D felony charge of possession of a controlled substance except 35 grams or less of Marijuana/Synthetic Cannabinoid. Bond set at \$20,000 cash or surety. Martin remains in the Randolph County Jail in lieu of the required bond.

On April 18th, Deron Maurice Williams, 23 of St. Louis was served a Randolph County warrant for failure to appear on a class A misdemeanor charge of domestic assault – 3rd degree – 1st/2nd offense. Bond set at \$2,500 cash only. Williams remains in the Randolph County Jail in lieu of the required bond.

On April 18th, Chyanne Lee Reno, 19 of Renick was served a Randolph County warrant for failure to appear on a class D misdemeanor charge of driving while revoked/suspended – 1st offense and a class D misdemeanor charge of owner operated motor vehicle without maintaining financial responsibility – 1st offense. Bond set at \$150 cash only. Reno posted the required bond and released.

On April 18th, Brandon Eugene Vanbibber, 33 of Moberly was served two Randolph County warrants. Warrant one on a class B felony charge of burglary 1st degree. Bond set at \$25,000 cash or surety. Warrant two for a probation violation for a class C felony charge of burglary – 2nd degree. Bond set at \$20,000 cash only. Vanbibber remains in the Randolph County Jail in lieu of the required bond.
